## Illinois School Referenda Election Results – February 22, 2005

### SCHOOL REFERENDA: 17% PASS, 83% FAIL

Results of the February 22, 2005 referenda on questions to raise school district tax rates and to issue bonds reveal that 1 of the 6 questions, or 17%, were successful and that 5 or 83% of the questions were defeated.

The results of the tax referenda, based on unofficial tallies gathered by an IASA telephone survey, are reported in two sections: successful and unsuccessful.

The school districts are listed by IASA Region and then by county within the Region; the county is determined by the location of the district's administrative office. The fourth column of the chart on results, \$ INC/\$ DEC, indicates either (1) the rate increase or rate decrease for the education and operations fund.

An analysis of the referenda results follows:
