School Superintendents Honored for Expertise and Leadership

SPRINGFIELD — Twenty-one superintendents across Illinois named 2018 Regional Superintendents of Distinction were honored Tuesday, May 1 during a luncheon in Springfield. It was the fourth annual awards luncheon sponsored by Horace Mann Companies, Illinois Association of School Administrators, Illinois State Board of Education and Illinois Principals Association.

Superintendents of Distinction are selected by their peers in each of the 21 different IASA regions based on leadership, communication, professionalism and community involvement.

"These unique individuals in the field of Illinois public education are providing exceptional leadership and are industrious in developing creative contributions that elevate the success of students in their districts and support solutions to growing demands," said IASA Executive Director Dr. Brent Clark.

The featured speaker at this year's event was State Superintendent Dr. Tony Smith. Also present was Dr. David Schuler, winner of both the 2018 Illinois and National Superintendent of the Year awards. Schuler is currently superintendent of Township High School District 214 in Arlington Heights. He is the first Illinois superintendent to receive the national honor.

"Our superintendents and principals are shepherding schools through a transformational time in education," State Superintendent of Education Tony Smith, Ph. D. said. "The leaders we honored today are among those going above and beyond to maximize opportunities and outcomes for each and every student. These leaders are not just building up their communities but also the social and economic future of our state."
